5 ways to

Become a Better Saver

It's easy to postpone starting to save, but a solid plan is key to success. By following some basic guidelines, you are more likely to achieve financial security. We recommend beginning with these five steps:

- 1. START NOW. The earlier and more you save, the more your money will grow. That's the beauty of compound interest. You earn interest not only on what you save, but also on the dividends generated. It keeps
- 2. SAVE WHAT YOU CAN. Consistency is the name of the game here. It doesn't matter how much you start out saving. You just want to make sure you make regular deposits. If you can start with only \$10 a paycheck, do that now. When you see how that works, you can raise the amount to \$25, \$50 or more over time. Ultimately, if you can work up to placing 10 percent of your paycheck into savings, you should be in great shape.
- **3. MAKE IT AUTOMATIC.** Use automated transfers to get in the habit of saving. Money can be transferred from your account without you seeing it, which makes you less likely to miss it. You can set up automatic transfers in Online Branch, through Mobile Banking or with a service representative. Another option is to have your employer directly deposit a set amount into savings from your paycheck.
- **4. PLAN AHEAD**. It might be too late to get a big head start on saving for the holidays, but you can start preparing for next year. Open a "Christmas Club" savings account and begin setting money aside for holiday gifts. Other secondary savings accounts can be used for vacations or other planned expenses.
- 5. TAKE ADVANTAGE OF SPECIAL RATES. Whereas savings rates have been relatively low in recent years, that doesn't mean there aren't exceptions. Keep an eye out for special rates, bonuses or other promotions. If you see a good deal, consider taking it, as it could give your savings a little boost.

Q: How can I protect myself against ATM fraud?

A: ATMs are constantly facing high vulnerability to fraud. Those who are interested in committing fraud will set up skimmers or cameras to record your activity and retrieve your card and pin information. Each time you get cash out, your card and pin code are at risk

When you use an ATM machine, use your hand to cover the keypad when you type your code to hide it from cameras and spectators. Also, watch out for machines that display crooked signage or loose pieces, as they may have been installed with a skimming device. Notice your surroundings. If anyone suspicious is standing nearby, go to another location. Always remember to check your balance regularly and keep track of all transactions.
